The main ways in which people choose to leave a gift can include:

- Pecuniary bequest: Pecuniary bequest refers to leaving a gift of a set dollar amount determined by you at the time of drawing up or altering your Will.
- Specific bequest: This is leaving a gift of an item of value, to be passed on to the Institute for Respiratory Health in order to generate funds.
