The Institute for Respiratory Health Clinical Trials Unit is highly regarded as a premier respiratory trials unit in Australia conducting trials in asthma, COPD, idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, bronchiectasis, cystic fibrosis, pulmonary hypertension, and alpha 1-antitrypsin deficiency.

This appointment will be on a casual basis Flexible hours, preferably Thursday and / or Friday (5 – 10 hours per week). Benefits include generous salary packaging as well as a flexible and friendly work environment.

Responsibilities of the Clinical Trials Medical Clinician will include:

1. Under the direction of the Principal Investigator, responsibility for the medical component of clinical trials as required by protocol. Specific duties include taking medical histories, diagnosis, physical examinations, medical supervision and monitoring, providing medical advice, writing prescriptions and providing medical opinion for all patients participating in clinical trials. Opportunities to attend protocol related meetings both interstate and overseas exist.
2. Working closely with other members of the Clinical Trials Unit and sponsors to ensure that data of the highest quality is collected, Good Clinical Practice is performed, and protocols are followed.

- Details of Primary Medical Degree and/or other degrees
- Willingness to get a National Police Clearance certificate or copy of your Criminal Record Screening Card
